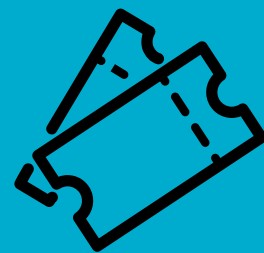

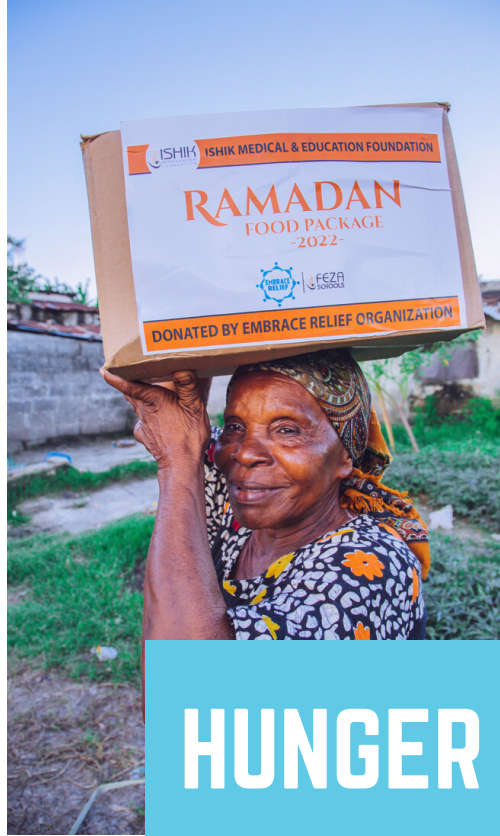

## OTHER FOOD DISTRIBUTION

- Distributed hot meals, clothing, and self-care products to 200 homeless people at Herald Square, Manhattan in collaboration with Youth Island NY
- In partnership with Wellspring Community Center, donated 100 lbs of halal meat (600 meals) to Beth-El Center in Milford, CT
- In collaboration with Peace Islands Institute, donated 50 whole turkeys to CUMAC families in need and distributed 250 lbs of meat in 5 lbs packages at Toni's Kitchen and St. Peter's Haven

At the end of this program, **20 beneficiaries will become school principals**, while the remaining **4 will be school inspectors**.

Introduced Embrace Relief's R.I.S.E. Leadership Academy, composed of seminars and training aimed at providing leadership skills the teachers will need to succeed as school administrators and leaders.

# DISASTER RELIEF

## HURRICANE IDA -

**Donated food supplies and other essential household items to more than 140 families** and partnered with Atlas Foundation, Louisiana Organization for Refugees and Immigrants, BAJI, Catholic Charities Diocese of Baton Rouge, and Refuge Congress

## AFGHANISTAN EARTHQUAKE -

**Distributed food packages and kitchen utensils to 400 victims**

## UKRAINE REFUGEES -

Distributed the following: **50 packages of basic food aid** in partnership with PIGI Foundation, **20 tons of essential food items and hygienic items** to Bucharest, Romania in partnership with Fundatia Tuna and other international non-profit organizations, **10 tons of hygiene and food products** to the Red Cross of Romania, and a truck full of basic food supplies, clothing, and blankets to Ukraine Bucha City in collaboration with Lumina Foundation, Time to Help Netherlands, England, Belgium, and Australian Relief organization

## PAKISTAN FLOOD-

Distributed the following: **845 food packages, 4,000 hot meals, 185 tents, 800 net shelters, medical check-ups and medicines for 500+ people, and other kinds of support to 500+ people**



## KENYA DROUGHT-

Distributed the following: **Food packages to 10,000 families** in the town of Sololo which were one of the most affected areas by the drought, **60 lbs of food packages to 300 families** in Turbi Kukubfami village, and **55 lbs of food packages to 300 families** in Sololo town
