Their project involved the **construction of a modern bathroom facility at a school in Tanzania**. That might sound like no big deal. But because the Academy worked hard and completed their project, **students in that community in Tanzania now go to school each day in a much more sanitary environment**. They'll benefit from reduced spread of diseases and higher rates of school attendance and educational success. And that will be true for the students in that school next year, and the year after that, and so on.

Depending on which project you choose, you could also have the chance to visit a new part of the world, immerse yourself in a new culture, and have the opportunity to gain a sense of purpose, fulfillment, and compassion. You would have the opportunity to meet the very people you are helping, and you may even inspire others to follow in your shoes. As we at Embrace Relief can tell you, making others' lives better is a wonderful, energizing thing – it just feels good to do.

Finally, because Embrace Relief is a nonprofit organization, if you decide to become a Group FUNdraiser volunteer, you may also be eligible to win very prestigious awards recognizing your work, boosting your resume or college application even further.

If you are **between the ages of 5 and 26,** your volunteer work with Embrace
Relief could qualify you to receive the **President's Volunteer Service Award,**which recognizes people who are
making a difference in their
communities and inspiring others to do
so. Depending on your age, you can
qualify for an award by volunteering for
at least 26 hours (age 5-10), 50 hours
(age 11-15), or 100 hours (age 16-26).



If you are **between the ages of 14 and 24,** you can qualify to receive **Congressional Award**, which recognizes young people throughout the U.S. who show initiative, service and achievement in helping others. With 30 hours of work on your Group FUNdraiser project, you would be eligible for a Congressional Award Bronze Certificate; the more hours you put in, the higher tier of award you can earn, and the more recognition you and your group members receive.
