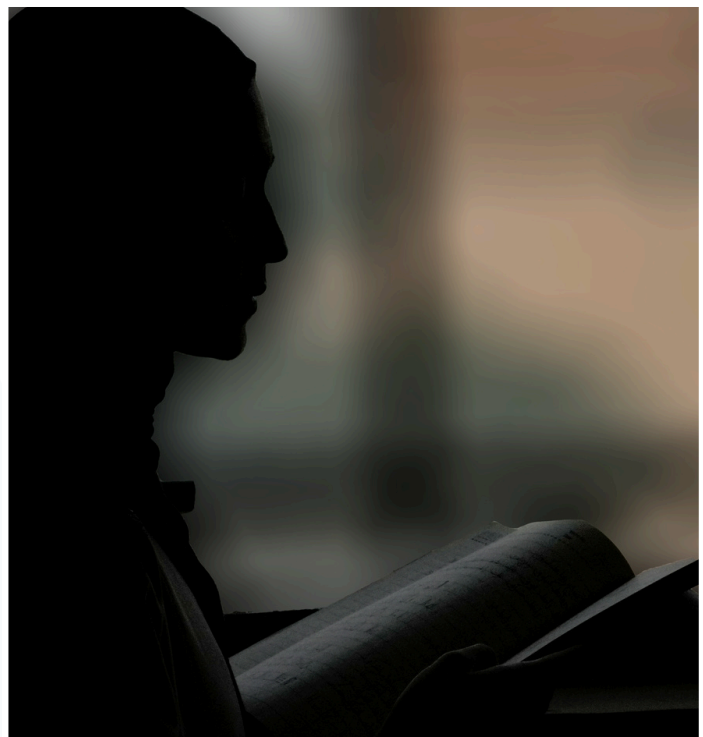

# GROUP FUNDRAISING

## 6 organizations

- **Fulton Science Academy:**  
Opened 5 water wells in Tanzania

- **Bergen Charter High School:**  
Opened a water well, painted school classrooms and distributed food to orphanages in Kenya

- **East Pennsylvania student group:**  
Opened a water well, restored two schools, distributed food packages, and helped Albino children in Tanzania

- **NOICA Youth group:**  
Opened a water well, organized a book drive, and distributed food packages in Tanzania

- **Peace Islands Institute:**  
Distributed school supplies and food packages in Uganda

- **Midwest Leadership Program students:**  
Opened a water well, distributed solar panels, provided food packages, and visited an orphanage in Kenya
